Southwark Pensioners Centre Name of role: Garden volunteer Purpose of the role: 1. To maintain a small and secluded private garden for members, users and staff. 2. To provide light gardening for the gardens of members and users as part of the member support scheme.

Mission

What will I do?	 Light jobs associated with a small private garden: Strimming Grass cutting Weeding Waste disposal Hedge trimming Planting
Who will I work with?	 Other garden volunteers Member support volunteers Members and users Trustees The Centre Manager as your main contact and supervisor Other SPC staff and volunteers
How much time will I need to give?	 We are asking for a minimum commitment of half a day a week for week for six months. There is flexibility about whether you volunteer with us weekly, fortnightly or monthly but we know that older people value continuity.
What do I need to do this role?	 Be friendly, helpful, kind and caring Be able to treat people with dignity, empathy and respect Be able to understand and respect the personal values, culture and beliefs of members and service users Able to work as part of a small team Be well organised

Are there any other requirements?	 As you will be working with vulnerable older people, we will take up two references and an enhanced DBS check (data barring service). (This is not required if you just volunteer at the centre or work under direct supervision outside the centre at a user's home). We ask you to attend an induction, role related training, and to come to a volunteer get together every three months or so. We also ask you to sign a volunteer agreement about your voluntary work, abiding by our policies and your hours. We sign it too setting out our commitment to support and develop you.
What will I get out of it?	 You will gain the personal satisfaction of knowing that you are making a significant difference to the lives of older people helping them to be as healthy, as active, as independent and as connected to their communities as possible. You will meet new people and try new things You will learn new skills and be part of a team You will have fun!
What support will be available to me?	 We will offer you a general induction about volunteering at Southwark Pensioners Centre and training and support about the role itself. A named supervisor We will also offer you the chance to meet the other volunteers every three months to share your experiences, give us feedback and find out more about what's going on at the centre. We will make sure you work in a safe environment Reimburse reasonable expenses in line with our expenses policy
